

Emergency Housing Voucher Program

LANDLORDS: be a part of solution to end homeless in Aroostook County!

The Emergency Housing Voucher (EHV) program is available through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA). Through EHV, HUD is providing 70,000 housing choice vouchers to nationwide Public Housing Authorities (PHAs).

Locally, Caribou Housing Authority, in partnership with the Continuum of Care Program, is working to lease up 15 vouchers to assist individuals and families who are:

- Homeless,
- Fleeing or attempting to flee domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking or human trafficking,
- At-risk of homelessness,
- Were recently homeless or have a high risk of housing instability.

Caribou Housing Authority is offering a \$1,000 incentive to landlords who lease to an Emergency Housing Voucher (EHV) holder.

- One-time bonus per unit leased (can receive more than one bonus; one per EHV tenant).
- Incentive payments will be paid within 30-days of the executed lease and Housing Assistance Payment Contract.

If you have been hesitant or reluctant to participate in the voucher program, now is the time to give the program an opportunity
